Autism is a neurological disorder that affects a person's ability to communicate, reason and socially interact with others. It is a lifelong disorder affecting individuals differently and to varying degrees of severity. As reported by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC, April 2015) **1:68 children are affected by autism.**

## What is Parents Run AMOC?

Formed in 2004 by parents who saw there was a need to raise awareness and bring about more understanding of Autism Spectrum Disorders, it is comprised of a group of very dedicated parents who volunteer their time to improve the quality of life for individuals with ASD through awareness, understanding and tolerance of this disorder.

### Mission Statement

Parents Run AMOC (Autism Move-A-Thon of Orange County) is dedicated to raising public awareness of Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD). We strive to support families coping with ASD by providing information and networking opportunities to help empower them. Our goal is to help the community understand and better deal with the challenges facing individuals with ASD. We advocate for those individuals, who are often voiceless, to be accepted and respected as individuals living in our community. We aim to raise understanding, awareness, and community integration of ASD through education within Orange County, NY.

### Autism Spectrum Fund

#### Reimbursement Program

A portion of the funds raised through the Autism Move-A-Thon of Orange County (AMOC) goes toward helping families of individuals living in Orange County who have been diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorders.

A stipend is available for families with an Individual on the Autism spectrum. The stipend can be used to offset the cost of a conference, seminar, taking a course, purchasing books or videos helpful to families in better understanding this disorder. For the individual with ASD, the stipend may be used toward any item/service such as but not limited to a gymnastics class, music therapy, camp, toys, special diet item or supplements, etc.

Orange County families living with autism will be accepted with a completed application form, HIPAA signature page and a letter from a doctor stating a diagnosis of Autism, PDD, Asperger syndrome or Autism Spectrum Disorder.
